


# How to Request DO Sponsorship

## Introduction

Desktop Originator (DO) is an optional FNMA tool that grants brokers access to Desktop Underwriter (DU) services via a sponsoring lender. The sponsorship is free, and brokers using DO can obtain preliminary AUS findings for their loan applications. See [FNMA's website for DU/DO](#) for information.

## Step-By-Step

1. Register for DO at <https://technologymanager.fanniemae.com/broker-registrations>
  - a. At Step 5. Lenders, add our corporate name, ROYAL PACIFIC FUNDING CORPORATION:
